Under this agreement for 2017 Bedourie State School will receive

\$5,000*

This funding will be used to

- Ensure that 100% of students in Years 3 and 5 meet the National Minimum Standards in NAPLAN testing for Literacy and Numeracy in 2017-2018.
- Maintain the percentage of students in Years 3 and 5 who obtain NAPLAN testing results in the middle and upper two bands for 2017-2018.
- Ensure that 100% of all students in Prep to Year 6 achieve a C or higher in English and Mathematics for 2017.

Our initiatives include

- Working collaboratively with the Outback Advantage Small Schools Cluster to increase teachers' knowledge of the Australian Curriculum and how to teach it with integrity using the C2C units as a guide and across multi-age groups.
- Refining the Outback Advantage Pedagogical Framework and Curriculum and Assessment Plan to suit the individual needs of students attending Bedourie State School.
- Monitoring and reviewing student performance in both Numeracy and Literacy to both provide feedback and track improvement, via weekly reports, five-weekly data cycles and term by term analysis.
- Identifying students 'at risk' of achieving under National Minimum Standard or below a 'C' in English and Maths and developing an individual plan incorporating specific areas needing development and building upon strengths based upon the achievement standards of the Australian Curriculum, stating pedagogy needed to reach targets.
- Building teacher capability to plan differentiated lessons and embed sound pedagogical practices to improve learning, particularly in Mathematics.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Providing focused professional development programs for staff to build capability to address and enhance Literacy and Numeracy concepts and programs – in particular Numeracy and Explicit Instruction coaching and feedback. \$2000
- Utilising an additional teacher aide to target intervention and provide additional support to students to access whole school Literacy and Numeracy programs. \$2000
- Purchasing additional Literacy and Numeracy resources to support whole school programs and student needs. \$1000
