
- Ensure that 100% of all students in Prep to Year 6 maintain their current level, or achieve a C or higher in English in 2021.

Our initiatives include



- Building teacher capability to plan differentiated lessons and embed sound pedagogical practices to improve learning. (*Hattie and Marzano*)
